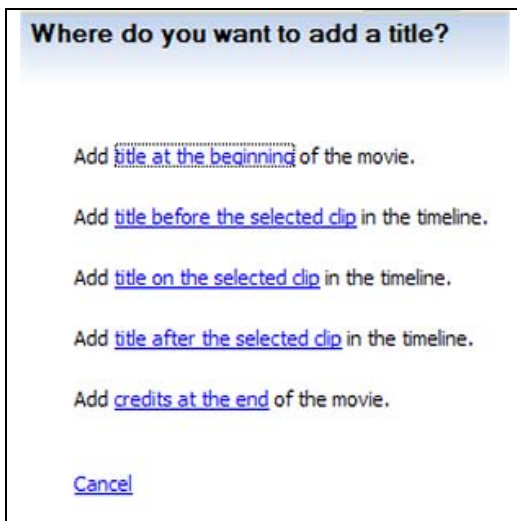
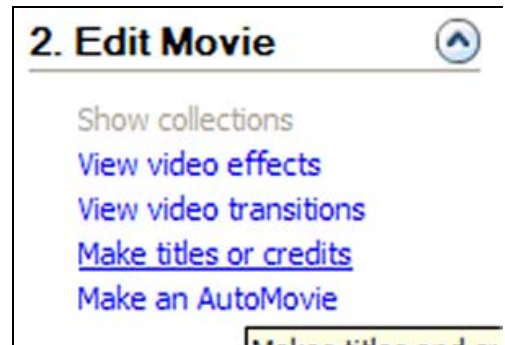

16. Titles and credits

You can insert titles and credits easily within Moviemaker.

In your Movie tasks pane click on MAKE TITLES OR CREDITS.



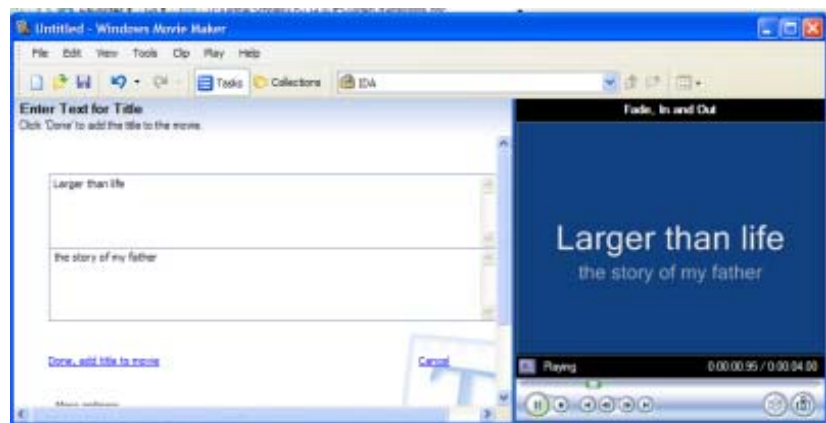
Select an option.

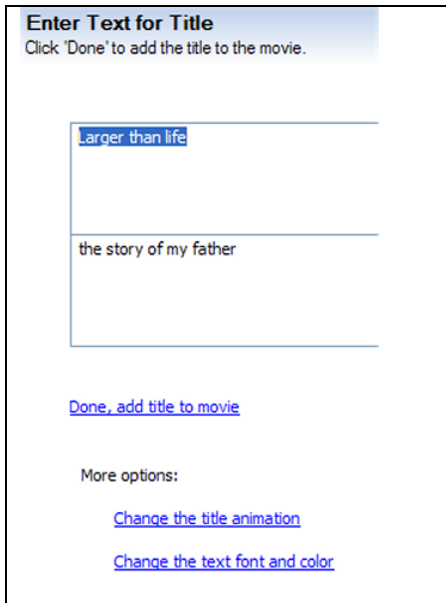
For anything other than the first and last options you will first need to select a clip/item in your timeline by clicking on it.

The titles options can also be used to add text to clips/items throughout your story.

Type your title into the space provided. Any writing in the top box will be larger than in the one below. You can view your title by clicking the play button in the preview screen to the right.

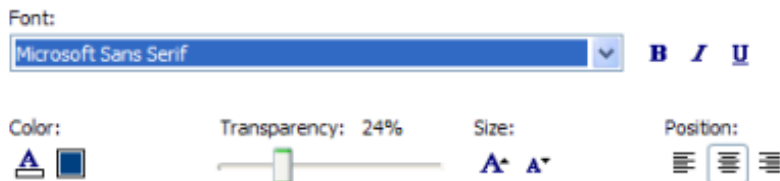
You will notice that it defaults to white on blue with a fade in/out animation.





To change the font and colours of the font and background click on the link under MORE OPTIONS below the text boxes.

You can also alter position and the transparency of the text here. The default has 0% transparency. For a more subtle effect you may want to increase the %



You can also change the animation of the text by clicking on the CHANGE THE TITLE ANIMATION link.

By scrolling down you can select from a number of options for one and two line titles, and for credits etc.

Name	Description
Scroll, Inverted	Video appears in text, scrolls right to left (overlay)
Paint Drip	Fills with paint
Titles, Two Lines	
Fade, In and Out	Fades in, pauses, fades out
Fly In, Fades	Flies in from left, pauses, fades out
Fly Out	Fades in, pauses, flies out right
Fly In, Fly Out	Flies in from left, pauses, flies out right

When you have selected the colours and effects click on the DONE, ADD TITLE TO MOVIE link.

NOTE – each format option allows limited characters. You may need to experiment a bit with more complex or lengthy credits etc. It is sometimes easier to spread the text over a few screens.
