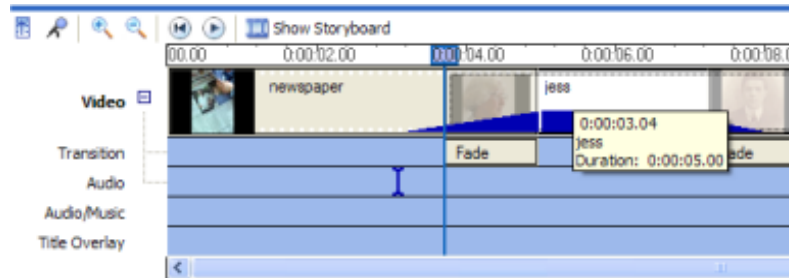
9. Video transitions

A video transition determines what will happen as your movie plays from one image or file to the next along the timeline. There will be a straight cut/line between two files if you have not inserted a transition.

If you drag one image or sound file over the adjoining one a FADE transition is added as a default.

To drag a file – select it by clicking on it. Now when you position the cursor over the selected file a hand will appear. Hold down your left mouse button and drag to the right or left.

You will notice a blue triangle where the two overlap – the longer the triangle the longer the transition period.

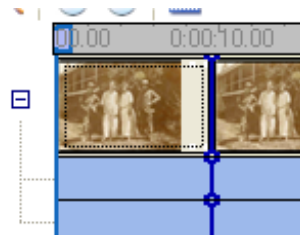

If you want a different type of transition click on VIDEO TRANSITIONS in your movie TASKS pane.

A wide range of options will appear. Drag the selected transition down into the transition line in your timeline in between the 2 images you have overlapped. A blue line will appear between the two frames when your mouse is correctly positioned.



Any transitions that you add will appear in the transition timeline. To delete a transition simply click on the transition name and click delete on your computer keyboard.
